

COMMUNITY INTERACTION PROGRAM

Through this program you will have the opportunity to make a real difference through sustainable, life changing project work that will improve the lives of the rural communities, protect fragile wildlife habitats. The program allows you to interact with poor African families, with your own hands play a major role in contributing to local schools in need.

Highlights:

- Work on important projects to improve the standard of living for rural Tanzanian communities eg class rooms repairs, desk making, tree planting
- Participate in ongoing conservation initiatives to protect wildlife and the environment.
- Learn about elephant conservation

Suggested itinerary – 10 days

- Day 1:** Arrive at Kilimanjaro international airport. Transferred to keys camping for dinner and overnight
- Day 2:** Transfer to Ndarakwai. The drive will take about 2 to 3 hours from Moshi. On the way get a beautiful view of Maasai land. Arrive at the camp for briefing and orientation. Dinner and overnight at Ndarakwai camp
- Day 3:** Early morning game drive. Return to the camp for late breakfast. If you are lucky you may see Giraffes, Elephants, Zebras, wilder beast, Buffaloes, birds and warthog. After breakfast rest till lunch time. After lunch participate in environmental activity which includes weeding and de snaring. On the way back collect elephant dung for making papers. During your walk you will be guided by the rangers. Return to the camp for dinner and overnight .
- Day 4:** After break fast participate with a specialist in making the elephant dung papers then back to the camp for lunch. After lunch visit the tree house including nature study. Dinner and overnight at the camp.
- Day 5:** After breakfast visit Maasai Boma. Participate with the Maasai women in making beads (bracelets, necklace). Return to camp for light lunch then back to Moshi. Transfer red back to keys camp. Relax and enjoy the African dance. Dinner overnight at keys camp.
- Day 6:** After breakfast, take a walk to a local school where you will be doing a project work including desk making, class painting, classroom repairs and tree planting. Dinner and overnight keys camping
- Day 7:** School project. Dinner and overnight keys camp
- Day 8:** School project. Dinner and overnight at keys camp

Day 9: Half day school project. Afternoon participate with the pupils in one of their games eg football playing. Dinner and overnight at keys camp

Day 10: Breakfast and Departure. Transfer to Kilimanjaro international airport

Price: 5- 9 people = USD 1070 per person

10 people+ = USD 1010 per person

Price includes: Transfer from and to Kilimanjaro International Airport, camping fees at keys and Ndarakwai ranch, game drive at Ndarakwai , meals on full board and mineral water, community project contribution fees and volunteer permit fees of USD 200 per person.

Price excludes: Items of personal nature.
